

UH-OH MANILOW!

BARRY MANILOW's cheeks have shockingly ballooned, leaving him looking like a chipmunk and experts declare he's the victim of disastrous plastic surgery.

New York plastic surgeon Dr. Matthew Schulman believes the 65-year-old writer of hits like Mandy, I Write the Songs and Copacabana looks like "he's overdone it."

After viewing photos of the star visiting L.A.'s The Grove mall, Schulman concludes, "He's had a neck-lift, a face-lift and more fillers or fat injected into his cheeks.

'Gone overboard'

"These procedures are normally powerful ways to eliminate common signs of aging, but Manilow has gone overboard, particularly with the filling of his cheeks," says the surgeon, adding the recent makeover likely cost over \$25,000.

Sources add that Manilow is no stranger to cosmetic procedures.

Experts believe he had his first face-lift in 1995 when he was nearly 50, a second along with upper and lower eyelid surgery in 2003, and yet another in 2006.

He's also had regular Botox injections, they say.

Michigan plastic surgeon Dr. Anthony Youn was so alarmed by the singer's look in 2007, he warned that Manilow was beginning to look "odd and unnatural."

"Overdone plastic surgery looks fake," says the author of the best-seller, *In Stitches*. "The best plastic surgery is work that looks natural and doesn't stand out."

In 2008, Dr. Toby Mayer, an L.A. plastic surgeon, noted that Manilow

appeared to have had extra-large cheek implants inserted and looks like a "carnival clown."

Now Schulman says he's gone overboard again.

"He's added too much volume

in the middle of his cheeks giving him a very unnatural appearance. His extensive upper eyelid surgery gives him a very feminine look.

"The overall results have eliminated any masculine features he was known for in his early years."
