

Kiddie pageant mom sparks OUTRAGE

STAGE mom Lindsay Jackson's shocking attempt to turn her 4-year-old daughter into a JonBenet-like child beauty queen – by what experts call “sexualizing” her appearance – has triggered a firestorm of outrage from horrified medical and family values experts.

After 6-year-old JonBenet Ramsey was slain in 1996, the kiddie beauty pageant industry was blistered by criticism that the tots were being made up and costumed to look like grown-up showgirls – which drew the sick attention of child molesters and other perverts.

Fake curves

Now, Jackson is being blasted for going even further with her toddler daughter Maddy. She gave the tyke grown-up curves with fake C-cup breasts and padding on her derriere for her appearance on TLC show *Toddlers and Tiaras*, a reality show about kiddie beauty pageants.

“The concept of enhancing the child’s breasts and buttocks is evil, abhorrent and caters to pedophilia,” Dr. Ted Baehr, founder of Movieguide and a family values crusader, tells GLOBE.

Medical experts were also shocked and enraged by Maddy’s fake curves that mimicked the hourglass shape of her icon, chesty country songbird Dolly Parton, as she wiggled her hips and shook her behind in a tiny, sequined red gown.

Dr. Anthony Youn, a Troy, Mich., plastic surgeon, slammed Jackson for making Maddy “look like a stripper” and the pageant officials for allowing it.

“As a plastic surgeon and father I find this absolutely disgusting,” fumes Youn.

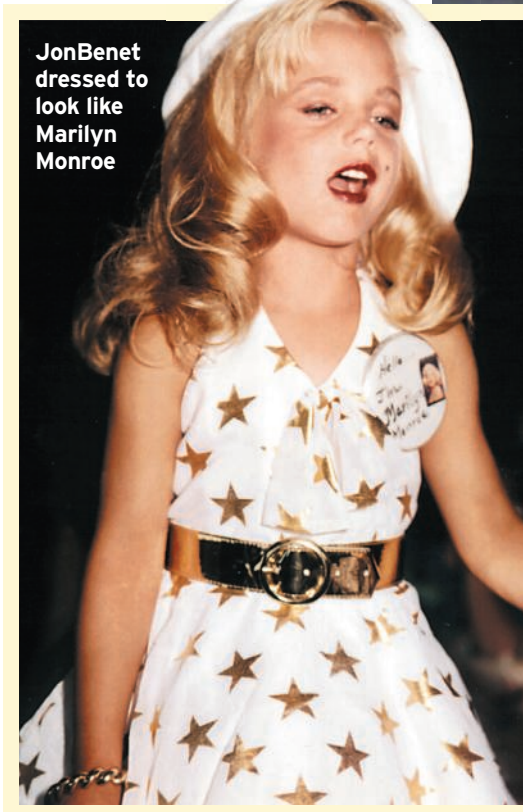
“Any parent who sexualizes a 4-year-old needs to be evaluated by the Department of Social Services.

“The pageant organizers who allowed this to happen should have their collective heads examined.

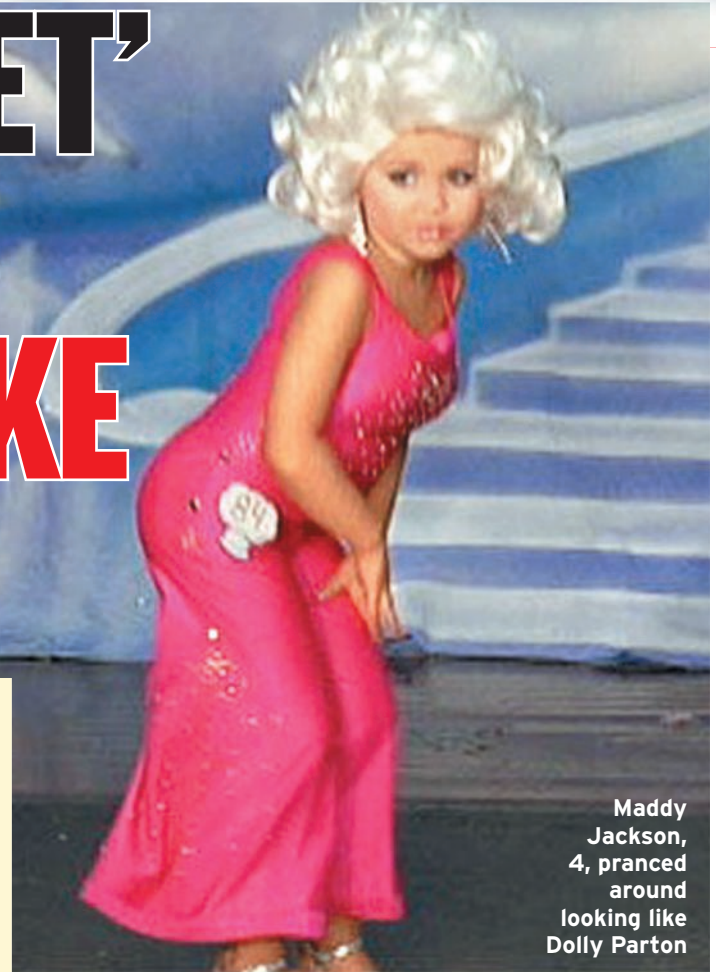

But Maddy’s mom tossed off the criticism saying the false breasts and behind were part of a harmless costume.

“To us, it’s just normal,” says Jackson, 29, from Mt. Juliet, Tenn.,

“It’s an outfit made for me when I used to compete in pageants. When she wears the fake boobs and the fake butt, it’s just like an extra bonus.”

Ironically, JonBenet’s mom Patsy, who died of cancer in 2006, later admitted that having her daughter heavily made-up and prancing in scanty, grown-up costumes at pageants may have attracted her killer, say sources.

A regretful Patsy reportedly sobbed about it at a family get-together, saying, “I’m sorry. I’m sorry.”
