**R**OSE MCGOWAN readily admits she’s had plastic surgery, but that was after a 2007 car accident left her with no choice. “I didn’t realize I was hurt until I put my hand to my face and felt the flap of skin. My glasses had sliced me under my eye,” she explained. Yet the changes to her face since then seem more elective than doctor’s orders. In fact, the actress,

37, had the Internet buzzing after her face appeared puffy and overplumped during a guest spot on *Law & Order: SVU* last March. But at the Crystal + Lucy Awards in Beverly Hills on June 16, Rose debuted a more sculpted look. “She looks like a few things have changed — for the better,” notes cosmetic dermatologist Dr. Kenneth Beer of West Palm Beach, Fla. “Her face

looks less stiff and more natural, probably as a result of more conservative use of Botox or Dysport,” he tells *Star*. “I don’t think she had surgery but instead probably had some facial sculpting with fillers — perhaps some Perlane in her chin.” Whatever she did, Dr. Beer thinks she looks great. “It’s nice to see that Hollywood is going human again.” —LYNN ALLISON ★



## AMY FISHER

The Long Island Lolita grew up fast, but now she’s trying to turn back the clock — by remaking her face. Since her 1992 arrest for shooting the wife of her lover **Joey Buttafuoco**, **Amy Fisher**, 36, has dabbled in adult films and checked into *Celebrity Rehab with Dr. Drew* for alcohol addiction. During a recent appearance on *Entertainment Tonight*, it looked like she’s hooked on another vice: cosmetic surgery. “Amy is a clear example of overfilled and overdone,” NYC plastic surgeon Dr. Matthew Schulman tells *Star*. Besides her trout pout, he notes that her cheeks have been augmented either with fillers or implants. As for her eyes, Dr. Schulman thinks she’s had upper and lower eyelid surgery as well as a brow lift. “Her brows now show an asymmetry that was not present in her earlier photograph,” Dr. Schulman observes. ★
